Charm Square Fun: Random 2" Hexagon Quilt Free Pattern Sheet

Approximately 54" x 71"

This quilt was designed for those irresistible charm packs. A 5 inch square is perfect for a 2" hexagon (HEX200). You can easily make the quilt larger by adding more rows. ~ JoAnne

Paper Pieces
277 - 2" Hexagons

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions

****Note a strip is considered the width of the fabric from selvage to selvage.**

For Hexagons: 277 5" Charm Squares

Backing: 57" x 74"

Inner Border: 1/2 yard

Cut into six 2-1/2" Strips

Batting: 57" x 74"

Outer Border: 2/3 yard

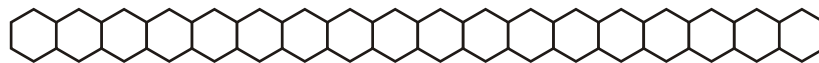
Cut into six 3-1/2" Strips

Binding: 1/2 yard

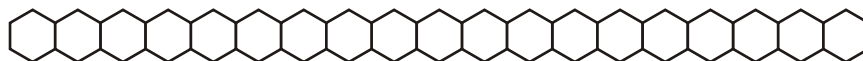
Assembly Instructions

1) Baste the fabric to the Paper Pieces according to the basic instructions. I like to baste "on the go" and whip at home in my easy chair.

2) Sew the basted hexagons together into rows.

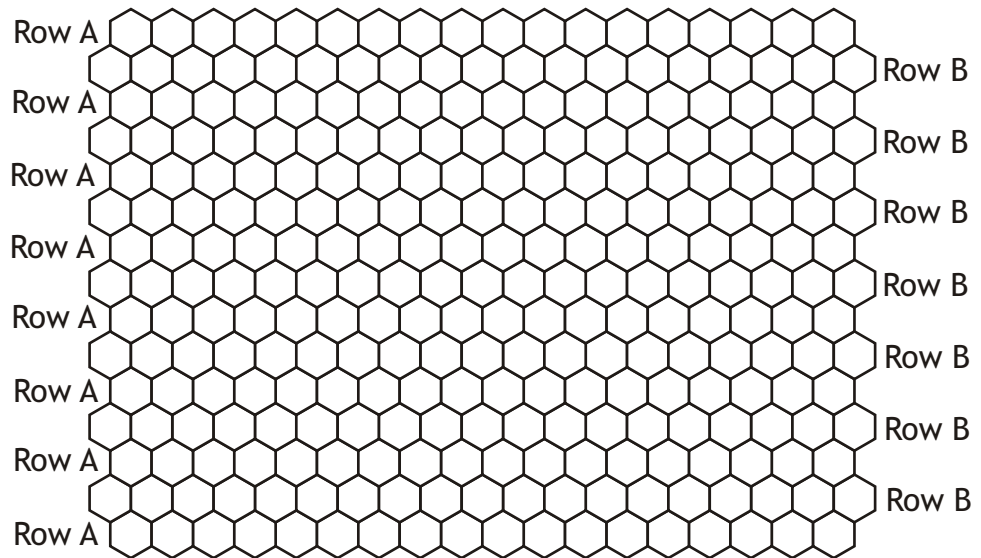


**Row A: 18 Hexagons
Make Eight Row A**



**Row B: 19 Hexagons
Make Seven Row B**

3) Sew rows together.



4) With your rotary cutter, cut all sides of the quilt even.



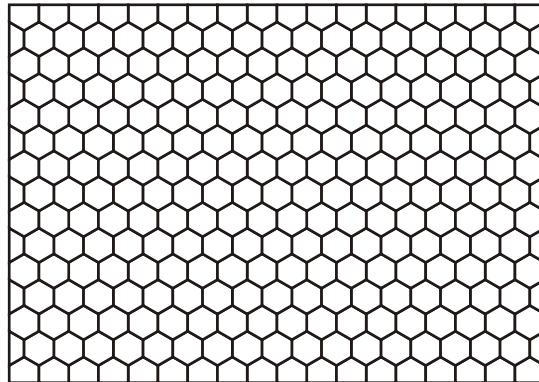
Place your ruler even with the edges



Cut off the excess



Remove cut pieces and continue for all sides of the quilt top



Finished Quilt Top with edges cut even

5) Sew the inner border on starting with the short sides. Then measure and sew on the long borders. Square off the corners. Repeat for outer border.

6) Layer Quilt Top, Batting and Backing. Quilt as desired. Bind.
